**PAYMENTS & FEES:**

**A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21 days thereafter.**

Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer; **all payments are required in US Funds.**

**Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.**

Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *Imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (03/10/26).

**GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:**

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers.

**Smaller groups may incur supplements:**

- \$150 per person (19-16 travelers)
- \$195 per person (15-14 travelers)
- \$295 per person (13-12 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 12 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:**

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur an **additional supplemental charge of \$1,425 for the basic itinerary.** Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. *Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.*

**ITINERARY & CHANGES:**

*Imagine* reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure. **All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee** plus applicable airline fees. **All tours are made final at 90 days prior to departure.**

**No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.**

**LAND ONLY:**

**Land Only price is \$4,597 per person, excluding international flights.**

Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

**AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:**

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *Imagine*. *Imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Group airfare pricing is based on the original group air contract secured by *Imagine*. Once contracted air inventory has been filled, any additional airfare secured for passengers—whether due to late registration, post-final payment additions, or changes requested by the passenger—**may be subject to increased costs**, which are the **responsibility of the passenger**. As such, *Imagine* cannot guarantee that all travelers will be booked on the same flights, particularly for passengers added after the final payment deadline as outlined in *PAYMENTS & FEES*, if airfare is applicable. Due to group rates, *Imagine* does not participate in or allow passengers to use points, miles,

All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

**PASSPORTS & VISAS:**

Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. ***Imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.**

**TRIP RESCHEDULING:**

*Imagine* and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

**CANCELLATION FEES:**

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged their single room fee. ↴

# The ITINERARY

## Day 1 – Tuesday, February 2: Depart U.S.A.

Tour members meet for our flight to Israel, the incomparable Land of the Bible. After dinner is served, sit back, relax, and enjoy the on-board entertainment as we prepare for this exciting adventure of a lifetime, walking where Jesus walked.

## Day 2 – Wednesday, February 3: Arrive Tel Aviv, Galilee

We arrive in Tel Aviv where we are met by our agent who assists us through customs and security. We are then transferred to our motor coach. Time permitting, we will have a short drive to Jaffa for sightseeing. Then, we drive to our hotel by the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

## Day 3 – Thursday, February 4: Caesarea Maritima, Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Druze Village, Nazareth Village, Nazareth

Today, we depart for the following Biblical sites: Caesarea Maritima, where Peter proclaimed the Good News to the Roman Centurion (Acts 10), Megiddo, and Mt. Carmel, where Elijah prayed, and God defeated 450 prophets of Baal with fire from heaven (1 Kings 18). Time permitting, we'll stop at the Druze Village for a short lunch break (not included). From here, we continue to Zippori and Nazareth (Luke 1 & 2), including a visit to "Nazareth Village" with detailed explanation of what it might have been like during the time of Jesus. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

## Day 4 – Friday, February 5: Galilee, Magdala, Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Jesus Boat, Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee, Jordan River

There is nothing quite like watching a sunrise from our hotel on the Sea of Galilee in the morning. We begin our sightseeing with our first stop at Magdala to see this new archeological site with the ancient synagogue, and then we drive to the Mt. of Beatitudes (Matthew 5-7), with time for reflection and worship. From here, we make our way to Capernaum, Jesus' base for His early ministry. We will visit the recently excavated "Jesus Boat" which is believed to have been built during the time of Jesus. We then board a present time replica wooden "Jesus Boat" for our Boat Ride on the Sea of Galilee. Next, we stop for lunch, with the option of the special, traditional St. Peter's Fish (not included). Afterwards, we see Gadara and then make our way to the Jordan River with the opportunity to step into that special river. Optional Baptism in the Jordan River will be available for those interested. We will have dinner and overnight in Tiberias.

## Day 5 – Saturday, February 6: Golan Heights, Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Tabgha, Beit Shean, Galilee

After breakfast, we travel north for the Golan Heights to lookout over the area at an incredible sight. Then, we visit Tel Dan and have a short hike/walk where we will see the gate of Jeroboam. Then, we drive to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made the good confession of Christ as "the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:13-16). Afterwards, we stop at Tabgha, the Church of Peter Primacy. Next, we visit Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Decapolis Roman cities. In Beit Shean, the bodies of King Saul and his sons were hung from the city walls (1 Samuel 31:10-12) after they were defeated by the Philistines. We return to Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

## Day 6 – Sunday, February 7: Jericho, Ein Gedi, Dead Sea

After our breakfast, we begin our day of sightseeing by traveling south toward the Dead Sea. En route we will make our first stop in Jericho (conditions permitting). Afterwards, we continue north for a visit to Ein Gedi where David hid from King Saul. We then proceed to our hotel at the Dead Sea for some free time to relax and float before dinner. Dinner and overnight in the Dead Sea region.

## Day 7 – Monday, February 8: Masada, Qumran, Jerusalem: Mt. of Olives, Palm Sunday Road, Garden of Gethsemane

This morning, we follow the road south along the western shore of the Dead Sea, where we will visit Masada. Here, we ascend the

wilderness mountain by way of the cable car to the fortress built by King Herod. We'll have time to survey the ruins of the fortifications, waterworks, synagogue, temples, and palaces. After we've made our way back down, we venture to Qumran and the settlement of the first century sect known as the Essenes, authors of the Dead Sea Scrolls. We leave the Dead Sea area for Jerusalem, an ascent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, O Jerusalem." (Psalm 122:1-2 NASB) As we arrive in Jerusalem, we begin our explorations with a drive to the beautiful Mt. of Olives to behold a breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. Our pilgrimage continues as we proceed down the Old Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane and its ancient olive grove. There, we will visit the Church of Agony, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed before his arrest (Matthew 26:36-56). We conclude our day with dinner and overnight at our hotel in Jerusalem.

## Day 8 – Tuesday, February 9: Jewish Quarter, Temple Mount, Southern Steps, Bethlehem

After breakfast, we enter Jerusalem through the Zion Gate and walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the Western Wall (Wailing Wall) of Herod's temple. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel. 24:18-25). On this site now stands the El-Aksa Mosque, and the magnificent Dome of the Rock (the third holiest shrine in Islam). From here, we take a quick walk to the Southern Steps to stand on the original steps that Jesus walked on as he entered the Temple area. Afterwards, we have a short drive into Bethlehem, where we'll stop for lunch (not included). On our way in, we'll pass by Rachel's tomb on the outskirts of Bethlehem! After we eat, we'll visit the Church of the Nativity and view the Shepherd's Field. We conclude our day as we travel back to our hotel in Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.

## Day 9 – Wednesday, February 10: Yad Vashem Memorial, City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, St. Peter Gallicantu, Via Dolorosa

After breakfast, we have a short drive to Yad Vashem Children's Holocaust Memorial for a visit. Afterwards, we travel to the City of David where we'll have the opportunity to explore Hezekiah's Tunnel (conditions permitting). Be sure to bring good water shoes with you should you choose to take the wet tunnel, as well as a flashlight. From here, we make our way to the Church of Agony at St. Peter Gallicantu. Afterwards, we make our way to the Via Dolorosa, including St. Anne's Crusader Church, Pools of Bethesda, the Sister of Zion Convent (to see the Pavement where Jesus stood as he was being tried by Pilate), Ecce Homo Arch, and the ancient Cardo. We continue to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight in Jerusalem. After dinner, we make our way back to the Western Wall for a visit to the Rabbi's Tunnel.

## Day 10 – Thursday, February 11: Israel Museum, Shrine of the Book, Garden Tomb, Farewell Dinner


After breakfast, we visit the Shrine of the Book Museum, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. You will be fascinated by the 1:50 scale model of Jerusalem as it would have appeared in Jesus' time. After lunch (not included), we travel via bus to Golgotha to the Garden Tomb (for a time of worship and communion. We'll have some time for reflections and private prayers as we wander the gardens before meeting back at our bus. On our way back to the hotel, we detour to a local restaurant for a special Farewell Dinner commemorating the end of an amazing trip to the Holy Land. Afterwards, we return to our hotel as we closeout the tour with a final overnight in Jerusalem.

## Day 11 – Friday, February 12: Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport, Return Flight to U.S.A.

This morning, we transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight home. At the close of an unforgettable tour, we bring with us lasting memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life and ministry of our Lord.

## Day 11 – Friday, February 12: Allenby Bridge, Jordan: Madaba, Machaerus, Petra

This morning, we depart Israel for Jordan via the Allenby Bridge, where we meet our agent and are assisted through security and customs. We board our motor coach to Madaba, the Moabite town of the Bible to see the Ancient Holy Land Map. Next, we travel to Machaerus (Mukawir). Perched on a 700-meter-high hill southwest of Madaba are the ruins of the fortress of Herod the Great. Machaerus is where John the Baptist was beheaded by Herod Antipas. We continue south to Petra, "the Red Rose City." Dinner and overnight are in Petra.

## Day 12 – Saturday, February 13: Petra, Amman

After breakfast, we visit Petra, a 2000-year-old Nabatean city. We'll walk about a half-mile through the narrow passageway with cliffs on either side (called the "Siq"). At the end of the Siq appears Petra's Treasury, a massive royal tomb carved out of the solid mountain rock. Time permitting, we will see Jabal Harun - the place where Aaron is buried. We then leave in the afternoon for Amman. Dinner and overnight are in Amman.

## Day 13 – Sunday, February 14: Amman, Mt. Nebo, Allenby Bridge, Israel: Jaffa, Tel Aviv Airport

This morning, we travel to Mt. Nebo to view the Holy Land from where Moses stood (Deuteronomy 34:1), a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley and the Dead Sea to the Mt. of Olives and the roof tops of Jerusalem. We then return to the Allenby Bridge for our return to Israel. After our border formalities, we arrive back in Israel and continue with a visit to Jaffa. Then we have dinner and an evening transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our return flight back to the U.S.A.

## Day 14 – Monday, February 15: Arrive in U.S.A.

We arrive home in the U.S.A. At the close of an unforgettable tour, we take home wonderful memories of the Old and New Testament, a renewal of our faith, and a greater understanding of the life of our Lord.
