Discussion Questions:

How does knowing the challenge that Satan gives change the way that you view this story?

Does your understanding of God's love for you revolve around the blessings only? How can you see His love in the midst of trials?

Share a time when you've seen God transform something that the devil meant to use to defeat you.

Have you been able to see Job as an Ugly Priest? How can you become an Ugly Priest for others?

Ministry Time:

It can be easy to slip into a mode of performance where you feel like you have to live a certain way to earn God's love and blessings. Pray for those who have been struggling with this.

As we talk about being Ugly Priests, God may lay specific people on your heart that you can reach out to. Pray for anyone who has a friend or family in mind that they will go be an Ugly Priest to this week.

Whatever the 'hedge' is—angels, supernatural force field, or just the wall of God's commands that say, 'No trespassing'—they keep us safe. I pray regularly for my family to be kept safe within God's
